



COOPERATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

POLISH NAVAL ACADEMY &

THE INSTITUTE OF MARINE ENGINEERING, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

By this agreement, Polish Naval Academy (PNA) and the Institute of Marine Engineering, Science and Technology (IMarEST) establish a global cooperation agreement which recognises the value of cooperation and the mutual exchange of information and ideas emanating from their respective activities and identifies and delivers activities where joint working is agreed to be the best way of delivering our respective organisational objectives.

Professional Development & Technical

- IMarEST to offer student membership to all PNA students (military and civilian) with the waiver of all fees.
- PNA to consider IMarEST accreditation (providing an independent peer review and quality stamp) for their academic courses and / or formal training schemes.
- IMarEST to support PNA in the technical delivery of the ASMOR Conference in October 2017.
- PNA to consider submitting technical papers for peer review and publishing in the JMET (or JOO).
- PNA to consider organisational membership of the IMarEST, either as a Marine Partner or Marine Member.

Proposed Future Work Plan

- **Professional Development**
 - Establish an IMarEST Branch in Gdynia.
- **Technical**
 - IMarEST and PNA to work together to develop a technical programme of joint seminars, conferences and events. IMarEST to consider Poland as the venue for INEC 2020.

Termination

- This agreement may be terminated by either organisation six months after having tendered written notice to the other organisation.
